Presentation to provide information regarding the SacRT Street Harassment and Transit Safety Survey.

As part of the statewide initiative to improve public safety, Senate Bill 434 (SB434) requires the top ten transit operators in California to conduct surveys to identify and address issues related to street harassment on public transit.

Between October and November 2024, SacRT launched a comprehensive outreach effort to better understand and address the safety concerns of transit riders. The goal was to engage riders and collect their thoughts on transit safety.
